The Israeli Declaration of Independence

- Issued at midnight on May 14th 1948
- May 15th a coalition of 5 Arab states try to oust Israel from their own land
- A rag-tag army with homemade weapons and a few guns left over from WWII



Taking Back Mount Zion

- Israelis fought Jordan military
- Israel surrounded by hundreds with only 25 bullets left
- A supernatural miracle occurs



Taking Eliat

- An uncertain mission but a successful capture
- Israeli Flag



Six Day War, June 1967

- Started by an Egyptian act of war
- Also involved Syria and Jordan
- Miracle against the Egyptian Airforce



Taking Back Jerusalem

- Engaged in a violent battle in East Jerusalem
- Stillness & quietness ... a trap?



Yom Kippur War, 1973

- Israelis fasting and confessing sin

- Rescuing 103 Jewish Hostages from a hijacked plane
- A modern day miracle

- Israel not actively involved
- Strange wind patterns



Massacre Averted

- Summer 2014 Hamas builds tunnels into Israel
- But it was a Shmita year, a 7 year cycle

Hanukkah is also known as:

- The Festival of Lights
- The Feast of Dedication
- John 10:22



168 BC Antiochus Epiphanes IV Ruler of the Syrian Kingdom

- Wanted to wipe out Judaism as it was the religion of Jews who lived in his empire
- Wanted a one world religion
- Desecrated the Temple



- Mattathias, priest of the Jews in Modin and his 5 sons refused to sacrifice a pig on the altar.
- Mattathias killed Antiochus Epiphanes' representative and then took off for the Judean wilderness shouting... "Whoever is for God, follow me!"



Three years <u>TO THE DAY</u>, after Antiochus' original mad rampage on Kislev 25, 168 BC, it is now Kislev 25, 165 BC & the Maccabees hold a dedication ceremony, or a HANUKKAH which simply means rededication



Hanukkah was born to commemorate God's faithfulness and provision.

The Hanukkiah with it's 9 candles gives us light. It was lit to celebrate the rededication of the temple and Jewish lives to God.



Matthew 5:14-16

- 14. You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.
