- Scripture distinguishes between true worshippers & false worshippers in the Church
- God the Father is actively seeking after true worshippers
- True worshippers worship NOT ONLY in spirit but also IN TRUTH
- Truth is according to correct knowledge & understanding of God's Word, which IS TRUTH
- A little bit of error or a mixture of error with truth poisons the whole lump & God hates such mixture

DEFINITION

Truth is that which is consistent with the mind, will, character, glory, and being of God. Even more to the point: Truth is the self-disclosure of God Himself. It is what it is because God declares it so and made it so. All truth must be defined in terms of God, whose very nature is truth. That is the biblical meaning of truth. Because the definition of truth flows from God, truth is theological.

- God the Father is "the God of truth" (Psalm 31:5; Isaiah 65:16)
- Jesus Christ is "full of grace and truth" (John 1:14). In fact, He is "the Way, the Truth and the Life" (John 14:6).
- The Holy Spirit is "the Spirit of truth" (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13).
- Jesus prayed, "Your Word is truth" (John 17:17).
- Paul calls Scripture "the Word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).
- Paul calls the Church "the pillar and ground of truth" (1 Timothy 3:15)

The test of truth must remain not what man experiences today but what the Scriptures have stated long ago.

The Bible is the touchstone to which all truth claims should be brought and by which all other truth must finally be measured. If something does not align with God's Word, it is not truth. It is that simple and that clear because truth means nothing apart from God. Truth cannot be adequately explained, recognized, understood, or defined without God as the source. Since He alone is eternal and self-existent and He alone is the Creator of all else, He is the fountain of all truth.

One must have a reference point or standard for what is true in order to understand what is false. In Christianity, the Bible is our standard for truth. Anything that contradicts the Bible is false. Anything that is added to the Bible is false. If anything is subtracted from the Bible, it also results in something false.

- 13. He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God.


God is making a statement here.

There cannot be any discord or difference of opinion between the written Word of God (Scripture) and the incarnate Word of God (Jesus). In the first place, truth by definition cannot contradict itself. Second, Scripture is called "the word of Christ". It is His message, His self-expression. In other words, the truth of Christ and the truth of the Bible are of the very same character. They are in perfect agreement in every respect. Both are equally true. God has revealed Himself to humanity through Scripture and through His Son. Both perfectly embody the essence of what truth is.



A person's worldview is their overall view of the world and of all that pertains to living in this world. Their worldview structures their beliefs which form the foundation of their values.
