Romans 8:1-4

1. There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
2. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.
3. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh,
4. in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:5-8

5. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.
6. For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.
7. For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot.
8. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Acts 2:1-4

1. When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.
2. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.
3. And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them.
4. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:5-8

5. Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven.
6. And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language.
7. And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans?"
8. And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language?

John 7:37-39

1 Corinthians 14:1-2

1. Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.
2. For one who speaks in a tongue speaks not to men but to God; for no one understands him, but he utters mysteries in the Spirit.

For one who speaks in an [unknown] tongue speaks not to men but to God, for no one understands or catches his meaning, because in the [Holy] Spirit he utters secret truths and hidden things [not obvious to the understanding].

1 Corinthians 14:3-5

3. On the other hand, the one who prophesies speaks to people for their upbuilding and encouragement and consolation.
4. The one who speaks in a tongue builds up himself, but the one who prophesies builds up the church.
5. Now I want you all to speak in tongues, but even more to prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be built up.

1 Corinthians 14:18-19 & 39

18. I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you.
19. Nevertheless **in church** I would rather speak five words with my mind **in order to instruct others**, than ten thousand words in a tongue.
39. So, my brothers, earnestly desire to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues.

1 Corinthians 14:4-5

4. The one who speaks in a tongue **builds up himself**, but the one who prophesies builds up the church.
5. Now I want you all to speak in tongues, but even more to prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, **unless someone interprets, so that the church may be built up.**

Operation of Spiritual Gifts (1 Corinthians 12)

These gifts are transitory (passing) & temporary. **The gift is for the occasion.**

Taking prophecy as an example. The message brought is given by the Holy Spirit for a particular occasion. Each time we prophesy it is a fresh gift of the Holy Spirit imparted to us, for that moment.

With the Word of Knowledge, we don't walk around seeing things "in the Spirit" with this constant supply of knowledge flowing into our minds! The Holy Spirit gives **a specific word for a specific occasion or situation.**

The operation of these nine spiritual gifts is transitory & temporary.

Romans 8:26-27

26. Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.
27. And He who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

Jude 20

But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith **praying in the Holy Spirit.**

1 Corinthians 14:14-15

14. For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays but my mind is unfruitful.
15. What am I to do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will pray with my mind also; I will sing praise with my spirit, but I will sing with my mind also.

Ephesians 6:18

... praying at all times in the Spirit

John 4:23-24

23. But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him.
24. God is spirit, and those who worship Him **must worship in spirit and truth.**
