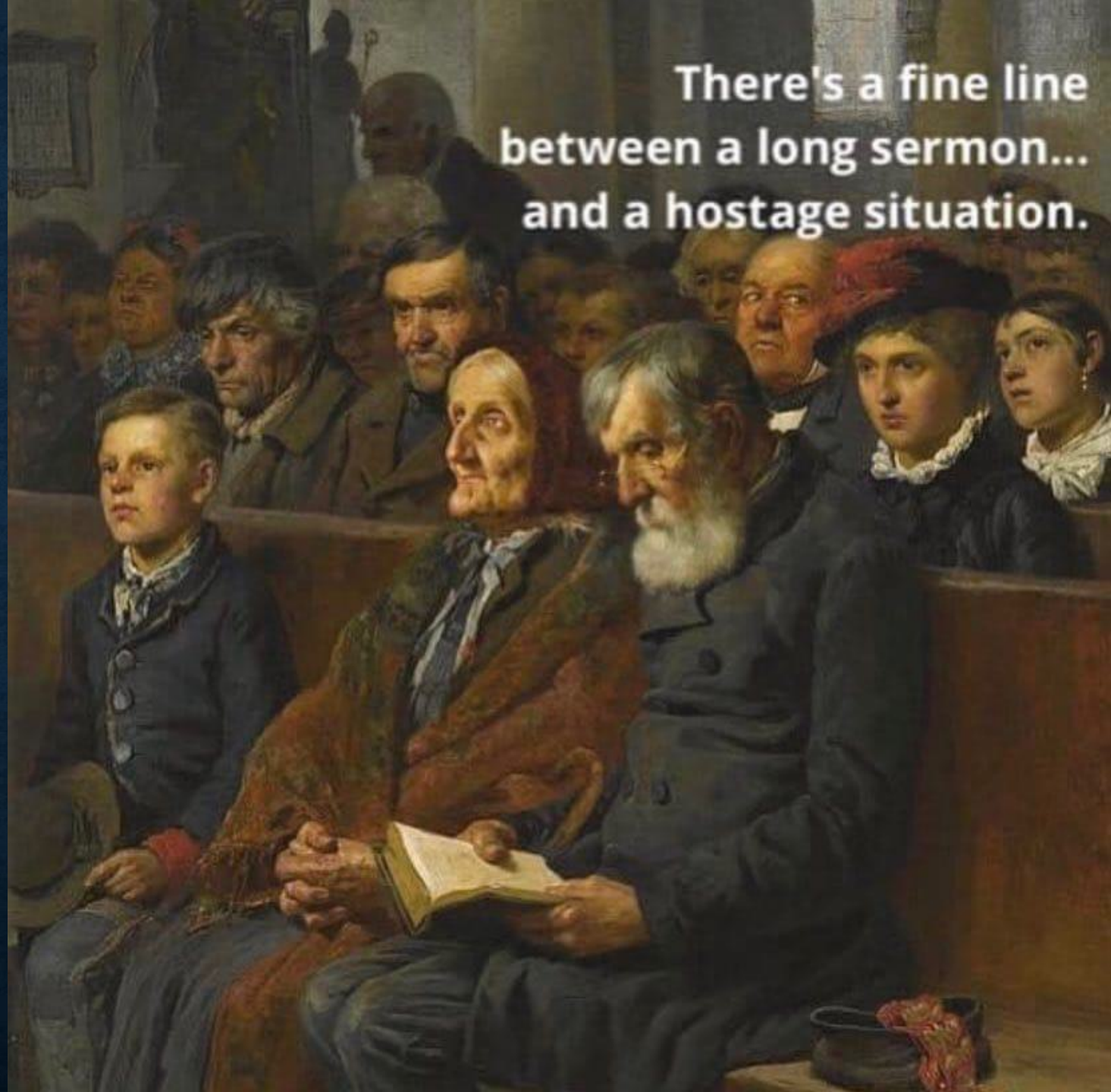


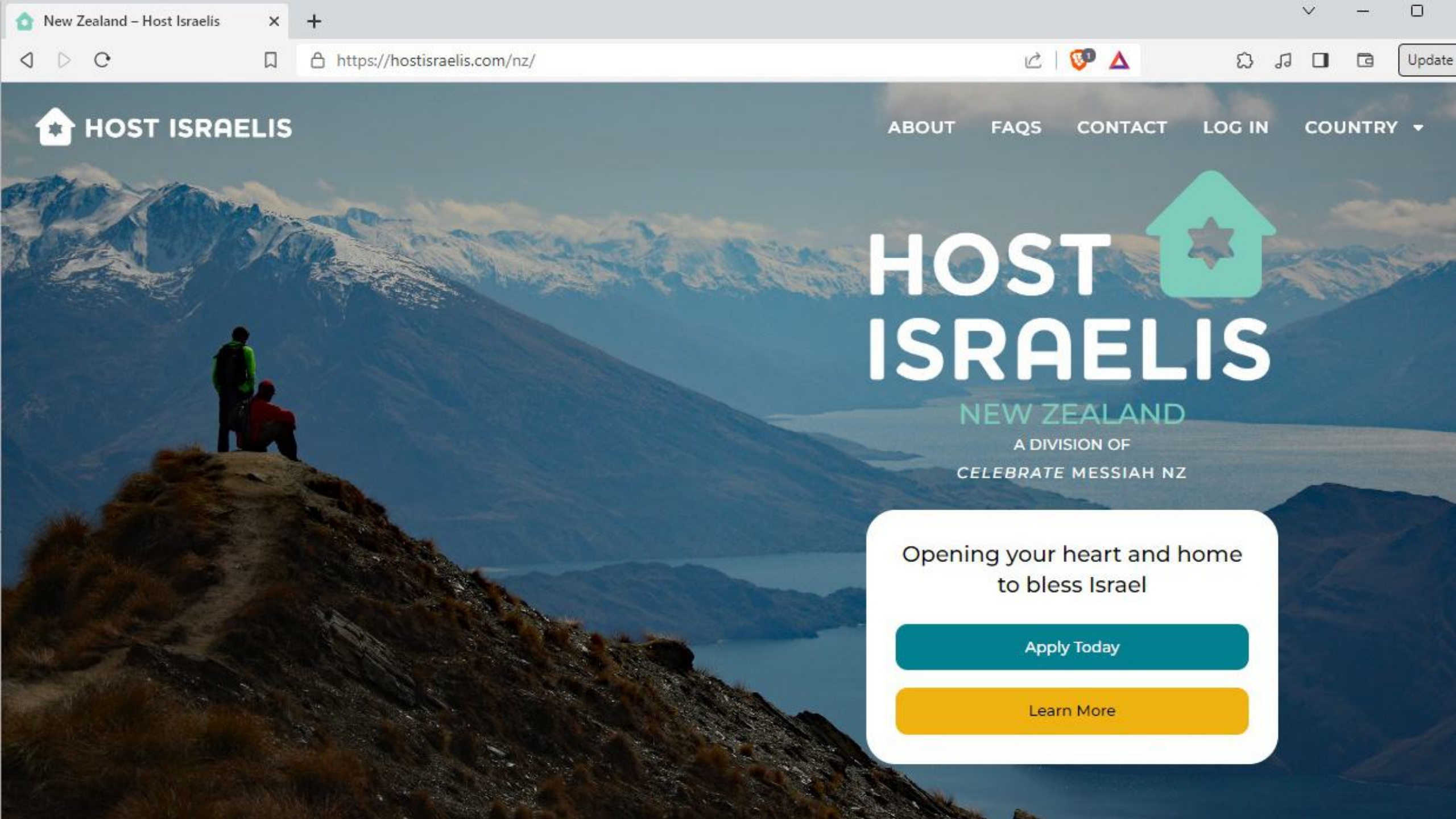

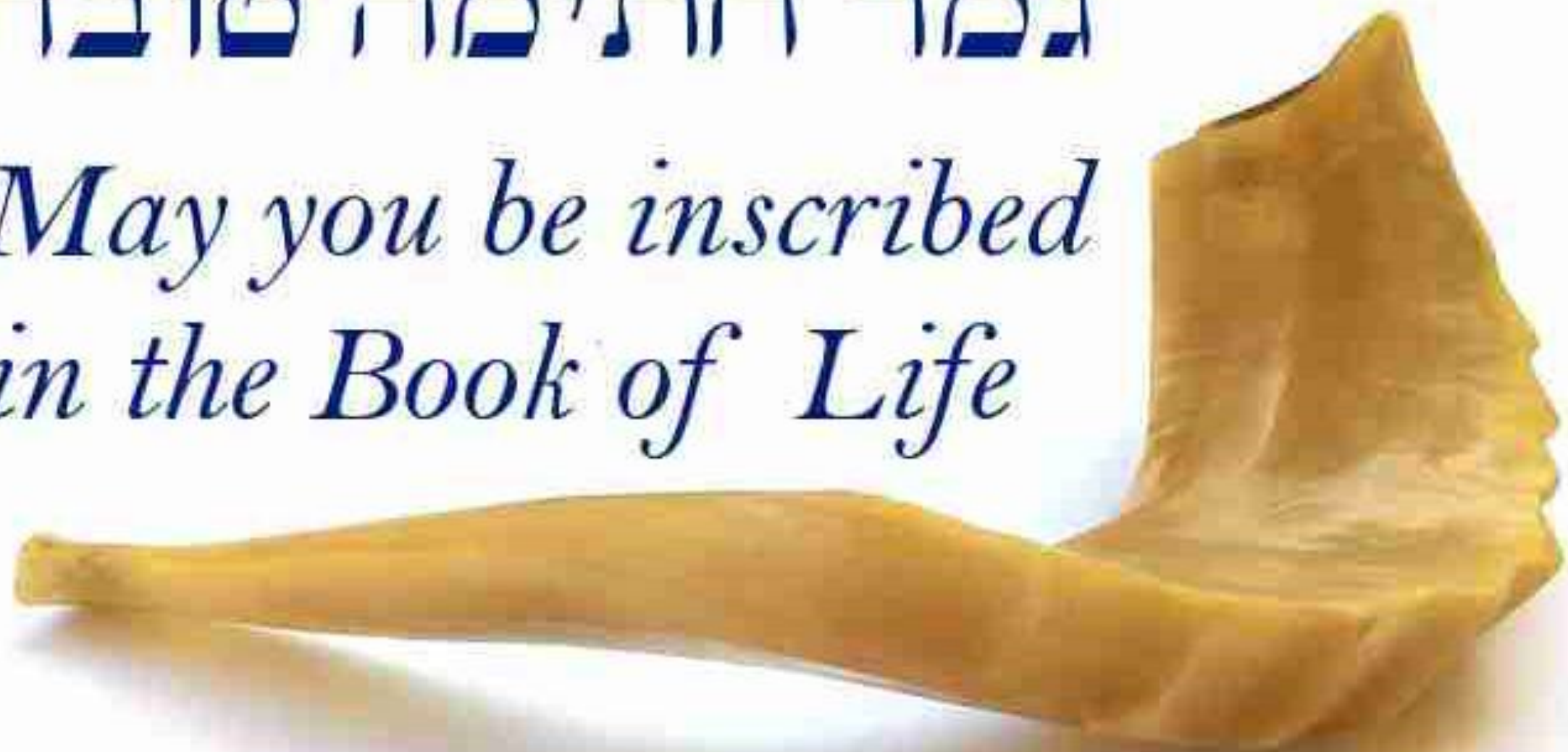
WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF A TRUMPET BLAST?

1. A Call of Alarm (“Return Immediately” / Repent)
2. Announcement of a heavenly event (such as a New Moon)
3. The coming of the King (“Lift up your heads”)
4. Announcement of a Marriage
5. Resurrection of the Dead! (I Cor 15:54; Rambam, 12 century)

WHAT IS THE OBSERVANCE?

During these ten days:

- People are acknowledging their sin, repentance
- **Asking forgiveness, restoring relationships**
- Repaying debts, **making restitution**
- Restoring a right relationship with God

LEVITICUS 23:26-27

And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, “Now on the **tenth day of this seventh month** is the **Day of Atonement**. It shall be for you a time of **holy convocation**, and you shall **afflict yourselves**... It is a **statute forever throughout your generations** in all your dwelling places.



HOLIEST DAY OF THE YEAR

- The High Priest (Cohen Gadol)
- Enters behind the curtain
- Only **ONCE** per year
- Blood atonement for himself
- Blood atonement for his family
- Blood atonement for the house
- Blood atonement for all Israel
- If rejected, the priest dies

WHAT IS ATONEMENT?

- Atonement is not merely forgiveness
- Biblical Definition
 - Atonement is the transference of the penalty of ones sin onto another, in which all the consequences and all the residue of the sins committed by the guilty party is placed upon the head of an innocent on behalf of the guilty.
- This is a **TEMPLE** requirement.

HOW DO JEWISH PEOPLE SEEK ATONEMENT **WITHOUT THE TEMPLE?**

“You shall afflict yourselves”~Lev 23:27 (not enough information)

- Works based atonement (not biblical)
- Waiving a chicken over the head (not biblical)
- Doing whatever the Rabbi says (definitely not biblical)
- **All of these** lie outside of the scripture, and none meet the requirements of God

HOW IS ATONEMENT MADE?

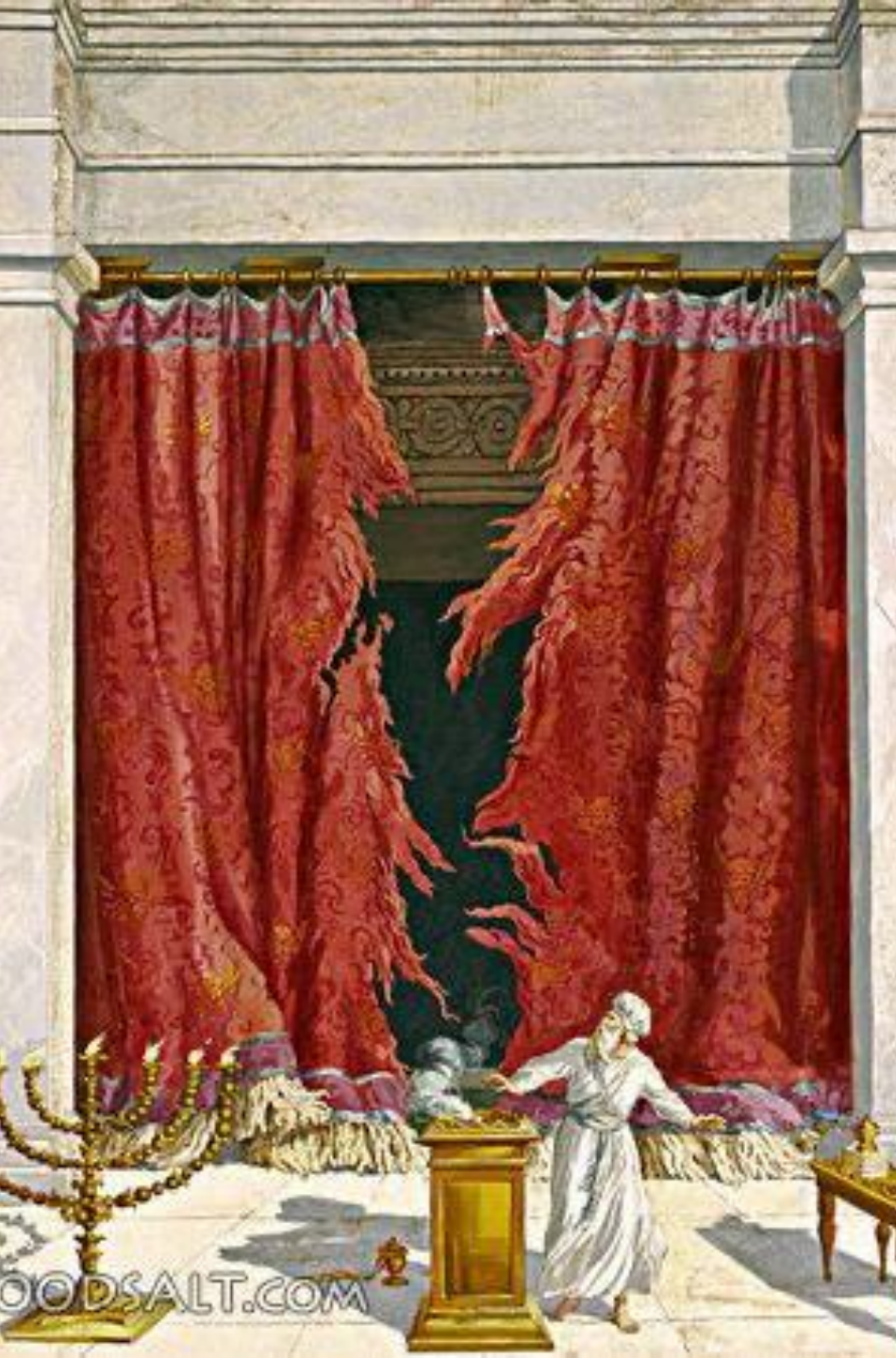
- For the life of the [animal] is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the alter to make atonement for your souls; for **it is the blood that makes atonement** for the soul. (Lev 17:11)
- Without the shedding of blood... no forgiveness of sins (Heb 9:22)
- The ceremonies of the High Priests were a **temporary foreshadowing** of the reality that would only be found in Yeshua's death on the cross.

GOD'S SOLUTION FOR PERMANENT ATONEMENT

*We have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. For every priest stands **daily** at his service, offering **repeatedly** the same sacrifices, which **can never take away sins**.*

*But when Christ had **offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins**, he **sat down at the right hand of God***

~Hebrews 10:10-12



THE TEMPLE CURTAIN TORN IN TWO

From the Cross, “⁵⁰Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit. ⁵¹ And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. Matthew 27:50-51

THIS DAY IS A SOLEMN ASSEMBLY

- Don't make light of Jesus' atonement!
 - His atonement is ALL SUFFICIENT!
 - His desire is NOT to condemn the world...
- ...but this day is NOT to be entered into lightly

If we say that we have fellowship with Him, yet walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But IF we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

~1 John 1:6,7

WE CLAIM TO LOVE GOD, BUT DO WE?

²⁰ If anyone says, “I love God,” and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen. ²¹ And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.

~ 1 John 4:20-21

CHESED – LOVING KINDNESS

²³ “Therefore the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants. ²⁴ When he began to settle, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents. ²⁵ And since he could not pay, his master ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made.

CHESED – LOVING KINDNESS

CHESED – LOVING KINDNESS

³² Then his master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me. ³³ And should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' ³⁴ And in anger his master delivered him to the jailers, until he should pay all his debt.

CHESED – LOVING KINDNESS

³⁵ So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart.”

THE AZAZEL LEVITICUS 16

- **Two Goats**
 - Representing Sin Offering
 - Representing Judgement
- **The Azazel Goat (Judgement)**
- **...shall bear on itself all iniquity**
- **Ribbon on the door of the temple**
- **Though your sins like scarlet**
- **Stopped 40 years before AD 72**

THE HIGH HOLY DAYS ARE TIMES OF DECISION

- We can either:
 - Seek His atonement
 - Accept His judgement
- Your life is on a razor's edge, you need to decide
 - Put your faith in Him, the atoning sacrifice
 - Trust in yourself, bear the consequence of your sin

ATONEMENT OR JUDGEMENT?

*Then I saw a great white throne and Him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. **And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done.** And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. **This is the second death, the lake of fire.** And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.*

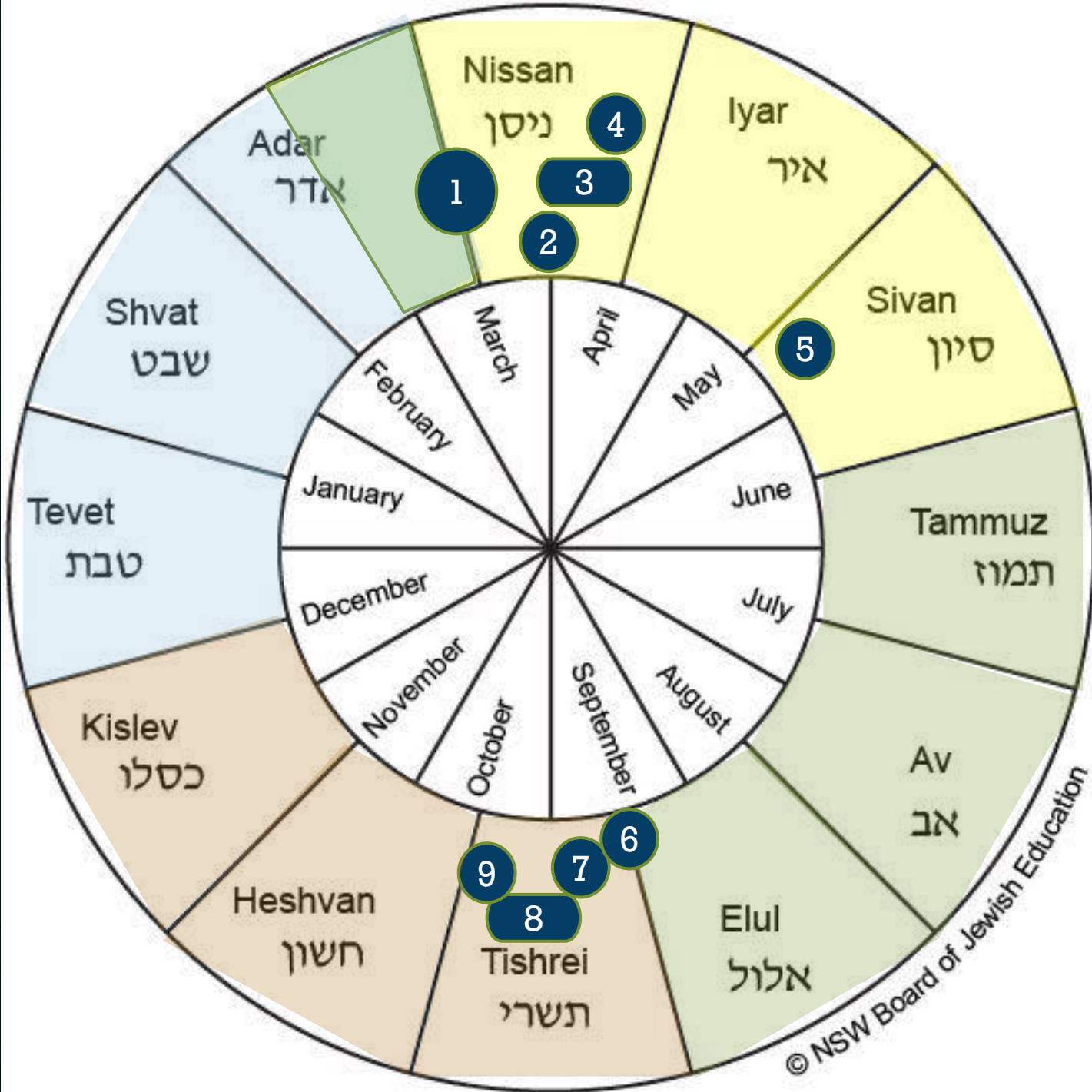

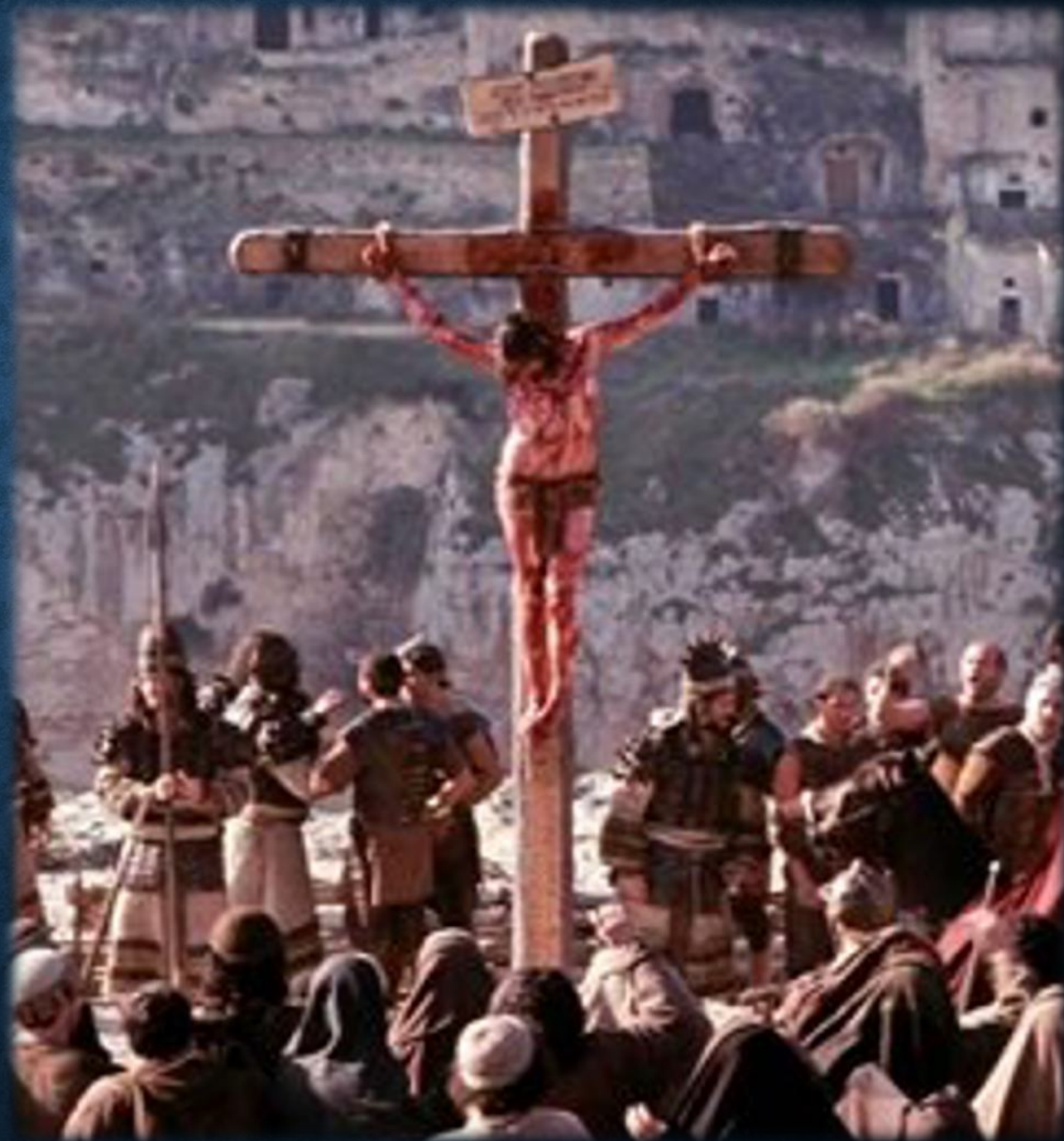

OUTLINE

- The feasts of Israel proclaim the Gospel
- But we proclaim the first $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Gospel, Jesus died for our sins, was raised to life and (find this verse)
- But there is a second half of the Gospel, and it's the second half of the feasts cycle.
- In the end, God will wake up the world... but some will refuse to follow him
- There will be a day of Judgement
- Then there will be a feast of dwelling together. (This is what God really wanted all along)
