## Ezekiel 39:1–3

---

1. And you, son of man, prophesy against Gog and say, This is what the Lord God says: Behold, I am against you, Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal;
2. and I will turn you around, lead you on a rope, take you up from the remotest parts of the north, and bring you against the mountains of Israel
3. Then I will strike your bow from your left hand and make your arrows fall from your right hand.

4. You will fall on the mountains of Israel, you and all your troops, and the peoples who are with you; I will give you as food to every kind of predatory bird and animal of the field.
