● You must be born-again

John 3:3, 5-7

3. Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again (born anew from above) he cannot see the kingdom of God."
5. Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.
6. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
7. Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

Romans 7:24-25

Zephaniah 3:19

I will change their shame into praise and renown in all the earth.

If we are tormented by **CONDEMNATION** then this is the freedom given to us by Christ:

Romans 8:1-2


For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.

For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.

IF ... & ... THEN

John 8:31

John 8:32

THEN you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

John 8:36

IF the Son sets you free, **THEN** you will be free indeed.
