


Living as Citizens of the Kingdom

You Cannot Out-Give God (3)




Colossians 1:13 He [Jesus] has delivered us from the domain of darkness and has transferred us to the kingdom of His Beloved Son.

Scripture tells us:

Living as Kingdom Citizens profoundly changes our handling of God's finances and provision in our lives.



Luke 12:13-16 **13.** Someone in the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." **14.** But He said to him, "Man, who made Me a judge or arbitrator over you?" **15.** And He said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." **16.** And He told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man produced plentifully,

21. So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God." **22.** And He said to His disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on. **23.** For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing. **24.** Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!



Luke 12:25–28 **25.** And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? 26. If then you are not able to do as small a thing as that, why are you anxious about the rest? 27. Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 28. But if God so clothes the grass, which is alive in the field today, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith!



Luke 12:29–32 29. And do not seek what you are to eat and what you are to drink, nor be worried. **30.** For all the nations of the world seek after these things, and your Father knows that you need them. **31.** Instead, seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you. **32.** "Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom."



Luke 12:33-36 **33.** Sell your possessions, and give to the needy. Provide yourselves with moneybags that do not grow old, with a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys. **34.** For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Stay dressed for action and keep your lamps burning, **36.** and be like men who are waiting for their master to come home from the wedding feast, so that they may open the door to him at once when he comes and knocks.

Luke 12:37-40



First point As Kingdom Citizens, Guard Against Covetousness Do not earnestly desire or long for or lust after something that doesn't belong to you.


Luke 12:15



Make Godly life choices and applications, based on Kingdom wisdom, which is knowing what to do through Spiritual insight and understanding.


Proverbs 14:12 There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death.

Wisdom is supreme; therefore get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding.





Be led by the Holy Spirit to walk how Jesus walked. Seek FIRST HIs rule and reign in your life.





When you open your hands, you open your heart to a deeper intimacy with God, Who is known by His giving."



Fourth point

Luke 12:33 Sell your possessions, and give to the needy. Provide yourselves with moneybags that do not grow old, with a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys.

In the process of giving to others, Kingdom Citizens begin to store up treasure in heaven.



Mark 10:29-30

 Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for My sake and for the gospel,
 who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life.
