

ASCRIBE to give or to count • to see, understand & acknowledge With regards to God, ASCRIBE means to see, understand & acknowledge the attributes, the nature & the unlimited capacity of God & to give to the Lord the worship, the honour & the glory that He is due. **ASCRIBE therefore is synonymous with worship**.

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23. Sing to the Lord, all the earth! Tell of His salvation from day to day. 24. Declare His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all the peoples! 25. For great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and He is to be feared above all gods. 26.
