#### Luke 6:27-28

... Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

# The last shall be first and the least shall be greatest! Luke 22:24-27

- 24. A dispute also arose among them, as to which of them was to be regarded as the greatest.
- 25. And Jesus said to them, "The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them, and those in authority over them are called benefactors.
- 26. But not so with you. Rather, let the greatest among you become as the youngest, and the leader as one who serves.
- 27. For who is the greater, one who reclines at table or one who serves? Is it not the one who reclines at table? But I am among you as the one who serves.





1 Corinthians 1:27 (Amplified Bible)

# Jesus conquered death and rose again on the third day!


#### Revelation 1:17-18

Jesus said: "I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades."


# God will reveal Jesus Christ to every single person who has ever walked the face of this earth and the outcome will be beyond outstanding!

For it is written, As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God [acknowledge Him to His honour and to His praise].




But ... FEAR MOIL



The Hebrew word translated into 'awe' in the Bible is yirah (יראה), pronounced yir-ah).

It often directly translates into fear, like "fear of the Lord," and it can also mean respect, reverence, & worship. But make no mistake about it, yirah is strongly connected to 'trembling'.





- 4. I tell you, My friends, do not fear (dread or be afraid of) those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do.
- 5. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear Him who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear Him!

### For those who fear the LORD there is:

DELIVERANCE 2 Kings 17:39

You shall fear the LORD your God, and He will deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies.

FRIENDSHIP & REVELATION Psalm 25:14

The secret [of the sweet, satisfying companionship] of the Lord have they who fear (revere and worship) Him, and He will show them His covenant and reveal to them its [deep, inner] meaning.

GOODNESS Psalm 31:19

Oh, how abundant is Your goodness, which You have stored up for those who fear You.

# LISTENER & PROVIDER Psalm 145:19


He will fulfil the desires of those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him; He also will hear their cry and will save them

- 18. Now when all the people saw the thunder and the flashes of lightning and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking, the people were afraid and trembled, and they stood far off
- 19. and said to Moses, "You speak to us, and we will listen; but do not let God speak to us, lest we die."
- 20. Moses said to the people, "Do not fear, for God has come to test you, that the fear of Him may be before you, that you may not sin."





#### Micah 6:8-9

#### Isaiah 43:1-3


- 1. But now thus says the LORD, He who created you, O Jacob, He who formed you, O Israel:




### John 14:1 (Amplified Bible)


### Philippians 4:6 (Amplified Bible)
