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EQUIPPING THE CHURCH TO DO LIKEWISE...

- Equipping the church to do likewise is a challenge
- The Challenge:
 - There is an great misunderstanding of Israel
 - There is an underlying distrust of the Old Testament
 - There is a widespread belief that the church replaced Israel
 - There is also an unnatural hatred for Israel in the world today
 - The church doesn't want to be caught up in politics!

THEREFORE MANY CHRISTIANS AVOID JEWISH PEOPLE

- Christians focus on the Gospel, but avoid Israel
- They Focus on the "Gospel"

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But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, the offspring of Abraham, my friend; you whom I took from the ends of the earth, and called from its farthest corners, saying to you, "You are my servant, I have chosen you and not cast you off"; fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. ~Isaiah 41:8-10

HOW TO WIN BACK THE RUN-AWAY BRIDE

- God's proposal to Abram & Sarai:
 - "Leave your fathers house, country, kindred to a place I will show you, and I will bless you (Gen 12:1)
- Accepted the invitation Crosses over in Faith (עברית)
- Entrusted himself, and all that he had, to God
- Enters into to the relationship that God designed him for

WHAT QUALIFIED ABRAHAM?

- Abraham was not a religious man
- There was no "law" to keep....
- Abraham was not a perfect man
 - "Tell Pharaoh that you are my sister" Gen 12:13
 - "Abraham said of Sarah, 'She is my sister" Gen 20:1
- Abraham often lacked faith in God
- So, what sustained their relationship?

GOD USES <u>TESTING</u> TO DEEPEN ABRAHAM'S <u>FAITH</u> IN HIM

GOD TESTS ABRAHAM (GEN 22)

Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!"

"Here I am," he replied.

Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love – Isaac – and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." ~Genesis 22:1

GOD TESTS ABRAHAM (GEN 22)

¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered up Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had received the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, ¹⁸ even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." ¹⁹ Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death.

~ Hebrews 11:17-19 (NIV)

ABRAHAM'S GREATEST TEST

The Lord called to Abraham from heaven a second time and said, "I swear by myself, declares the Lord, that because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, I will surely bless you and make your descendants as numerous as the stars... and through vour offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me." ~Gen 22:15-18

ABRAHAM IS THE FATHER OF THE FAITH

- He believed the LORD, and He counted it to him as righteousness... ~ Gen 15:9, Rom 4:29, Gal 3:6, James 2:23
- Without faith it is impossible to please God ~Heb 11:6
- For the Righteous shall live by faith
 - ~Hab 2:4, Rom 1:17, Gal 3:11, Heb 10:38
- Abraham discovered that "righteousness" comes by faith.
 That FAITH allows us to trust God to be God!

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ISRAEL'S PURPOSE IS TO MAKE THE NATION JEALOUS!

See, I have taught you decrees and laws... so that you may follow them... Observe them carefully, for this will show your wisdom and understanding to the nations! They will hear about all these decrees and say, "Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people." What other nation is so great as to have their gods near them the way the LORD our God is near us whenever we pray to Him?

WHY JEALOUSY?

- Why did God want to provoke the nations to jealousy?
- God is provoking all mankind to desire a relationship with Him
- through you all the families of the earth shall be blessed ~Gen 12:3
- The purpose of Israel was (and still is) to be bless the Nations
- They were to be his witnesses; a light to the Gentiles (Is 49)
- The gifts and the calling of God are unrevokeable. ~Rom 11:29

SO WHY HASN'T GOD GIVEN UP ON THEM?

IT WAS NEVER ABOUT THEM!

- The purpose of Israel isn't to demonstrate how great Israel is!
- The purpose of Israel is to demonstrate how faithful God is!
- In spite of the worlds hatred for Israel, God doesn't waiver

- Why is the faithfulness of God so important?
- God's purpose is to bring the run-away bride home.

WHY IS JEALOUSY IMPORTANT?

- God's <u>purpose for Israel</u> was to provoke the Gentiles to jealously desire a relationship with Him!
- God's <u>purpose for the redeemed Nations</u> is to provoke Israel to jealously desire a relationship with Him!

Don't believe me?

PAUL ELABORATES ON GOD'S PLAN

So I ask, did they [Israel] stumble in order that they might fall? By no means! Rather, through their trespass salvation has come to the Gentiles, so as to make Israel jealous.

~Romans 11:11

The Second Great Commission / Gentile Commission®

GOD'S MERCY ABOUNDS

For just as you [Gentiles] were at one time disobedient to God but now have received mercy because of [Israel's] disobedience, so they too have now been disobedient in order that by the same mercy shown to you they also may now receive mercy. ~Roman 11:28

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HOW DOES ISRAEL RELATE TO THE GOSPEL?

- God's not looking for perfection, religion, self-righteousness
- He is looking to restore a relationship established in faith!
- When we trust <u>Him</u> to be God, <u>we no longer have to be Him</u>
- We can relax, allow Him to be our <u>protector</u> and <u>provider</u>
- This will free us up to trust Him, and love others...
- That is the foundational relationship that as in the Garden!

BUT WE MUST REALIZE

- The heart of the father is revealed in Yeshua, the Messiah!
- For us to be restored, our sins MUST be dealt with.
- While we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!
- Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God
- Do you want to know the heart of God?
- Look at the life of Jesus! (Life, Death and Resurrrection)

BUT WHAT ABOUT ISRAEL? CAN HE SAVE THEM?

ZECHARIAH 12:10

¹⁰ "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

DON'T BE SHY ABOUT JESUS!

- I meet Chrisitans who are afraid to share their faith!
- They reason, it's impolite to convert Jews to Jesus!
- This is based on a massive misunderstanding
- The Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit said...
- "for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." ~Acts 4:12

SO, WHAT DOES ISRAEL HAVE TO DO WITH THE GOSPEL?

EVERYTHING!

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THE GOSPEL DOESN'T BEGIN IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

- The Gospel is throughout the Old and New Testament
- It doesn't begin in Matthew, it begins in Genesis!

"22 You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for <u>salvation</u> is of the <u>Jews</u>."

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
