Paul's Letter of Joy

Dear friends,

I write to you as an old man, weary and worn, my body broken and my strength all but gone.

I have endured so much over the years, and yet God, in His wisdom, has never chosen to remove this thorn in the flesh that you have heard about — a constant companion to my suffering, adding to my pain each day.

Here I am now, chained day and night to an unbelieving soldier, a harsh and unfeeling guard, with no conversation skills or desire. I have no privacy, and I cannot pray as I wish. The shackles bite into my wrists until they bleed, and I live in continual discomfort and humiliation. I do not even know what awaits me; they have not set a date for my trial. This uncertainty gnaws at me, filling my heart with deep anxiety.

My health has deteriorated — I eat poorly, sleep little, and I have lost so much weight that I hardly recognise myself. The gift you sent, the money you so generously provided, helped me to buy only the most basic necessities. I am deeply grateful, but my needs remain great, and my suffering continues.

My beloved friends, my life has become so difficult that at times I long simply to depart and be with Christ, to leave all this pain behind. I yearn for that final release.

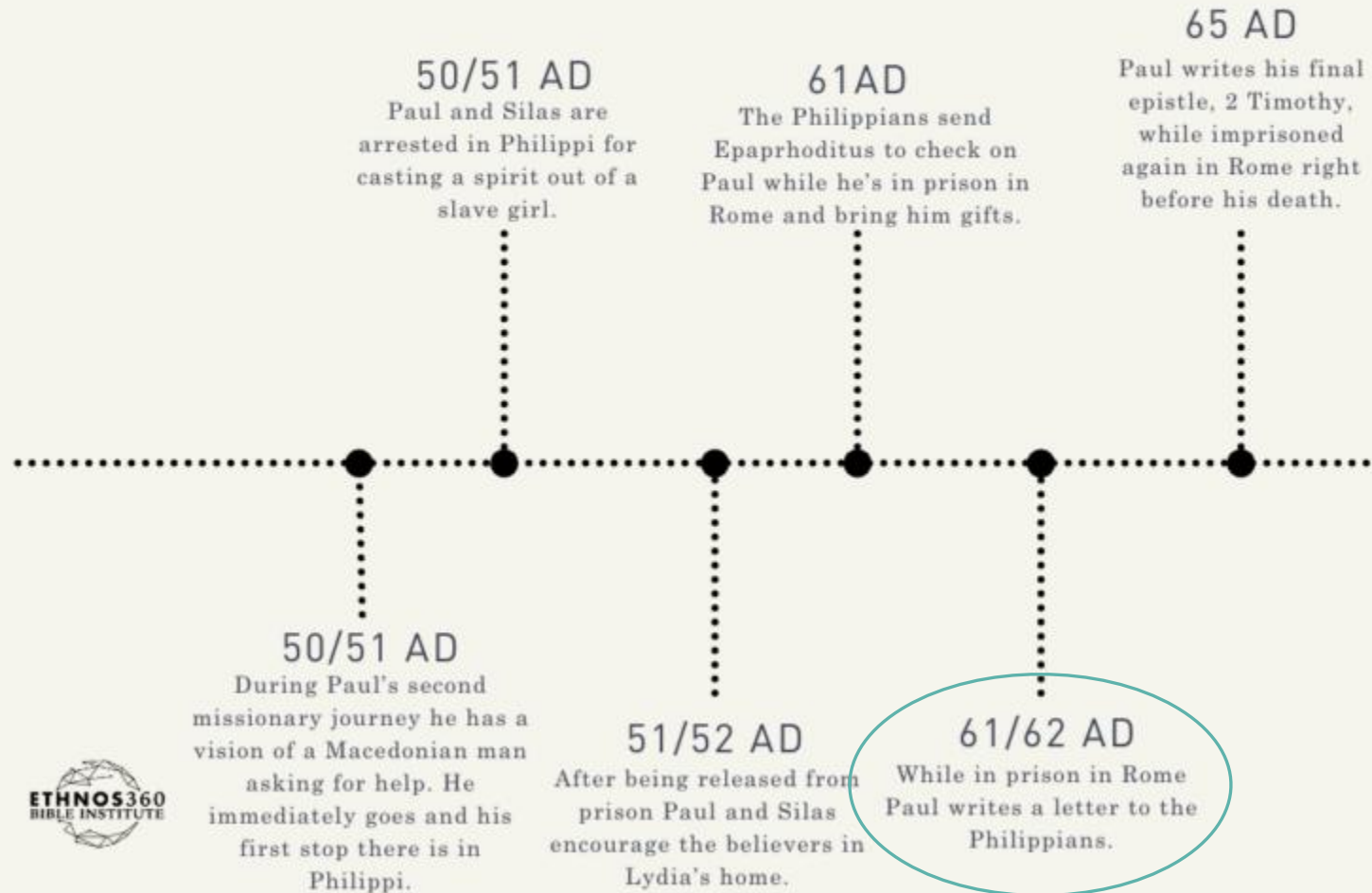
