**How do we express and demonstrate that love for one another?
Christians don't just go to church - we are the Church.**

If God's people are the Church, then the Body of Christ must show forth God in thoughts, words and actions.

Love One Another

Romans 12:10a Love one another with brotherly affection.

Romans 13:8 Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.

1 Thessalonians 3:12 And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you.

1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 Now concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love one another, for that indeed is what you are doing to all the brothers throughout Macedonia. But we urge you, brothers, to do this more and more.

Love One Another

1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

1 John 3:11 For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

1 John 3:23 And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as He has commanded us.

Love One Another

1 John 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.

1 John 4:11-12 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and His love is perfected in us.

Honour & Prefer One Another

Romans 12:10 (KJVS) Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another.

Romans 12:10 (Complete Jewish Bible) Love each other devotedly and with brotherly love; and set examples for each other in showing respect.

Greet & Welcome One Another Warmly

Romans 16:16 Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.

1 Corinthians 16:20 All the brothers send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

1 Peter 5:14 Greet one another with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

Romans 15:7 Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

Show Hospitality to One Another

1 Peter 4:9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.

1 Peter 4:9 (Amplified Bible) Practice hospitality to one another (those of the household of faith). [Be hospitable, be a lover of strangers, with brotherly affection for the unknown guests, the foreigners, the poor, and all others who come your way who are of Christ's body.] And [in each instance] do it ungrudgingly (cordially and graciously, without complaining but as representing Him).

Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.

2 Corinthians 13:11

Finally, brethren, farewell (rejoice)! Be strengthened (perfected, completed, made what you ought to be); be encouraged and consoled and comforted; be of the same [agreeable] mind one with another; live in peace, and [then] the God of love [Who is the Source of affection, goodwill, love, and benevolence toward men] and the Author and Promoter of peace will be with you.

2 Corinthians 13:11 (Amplified Bible)

Live in Harmony, Be at Peace & Be Kind to One Another

Romans 12:16 Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.

Mark 9:50 Salt is good, but if the salt has lost its saltiness, how will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with one another.

Ephesians 4:32 (Amplified Bible) And become useful and helpful and kind to one another, tenderhearted (compassionate, understanding, loving-hearted), forgiving one another [readily and freely], as God in Christ forgave you.

Forgive One Another

Ephesians 4:32b forgiving one another [readily and freely], as God in Christ forgave you.

Colossians 3:13b . . .and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

Forgive One Another

This might be one of the HARDEST things you'll ever have to do - forgiving someone can be really painful. To forgive completely — not counting their sins against them, not holding onto them, not justifying yourself, not allowing this to affect how we see them - is no small matter.

When the Lord enables us to do this, it feels, in some small measure, like Calvary love. It's what Jesus did for us!

Bear With One Another

Ephesians 4:2-3 With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

To “bear with one another” doesn't mean to simply tolerate others. It means to extend grace, to walk in patience, to choose compassion even when it feels undeserved!

Care for One Another

1 Corinthians 12:25 .. that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

Amplified Bible .. but the members all alike should have a mutual interest in and care for one another.

We must be genuine in our relationships.

Confess Your Sins & Pray For One Another

James 5:16 Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

If there's anything that keeps us humble it's sharing with another . . . "I've sinned. Please will you pray for me?"

4. Show His Love


1 Thessalonians 5:15
