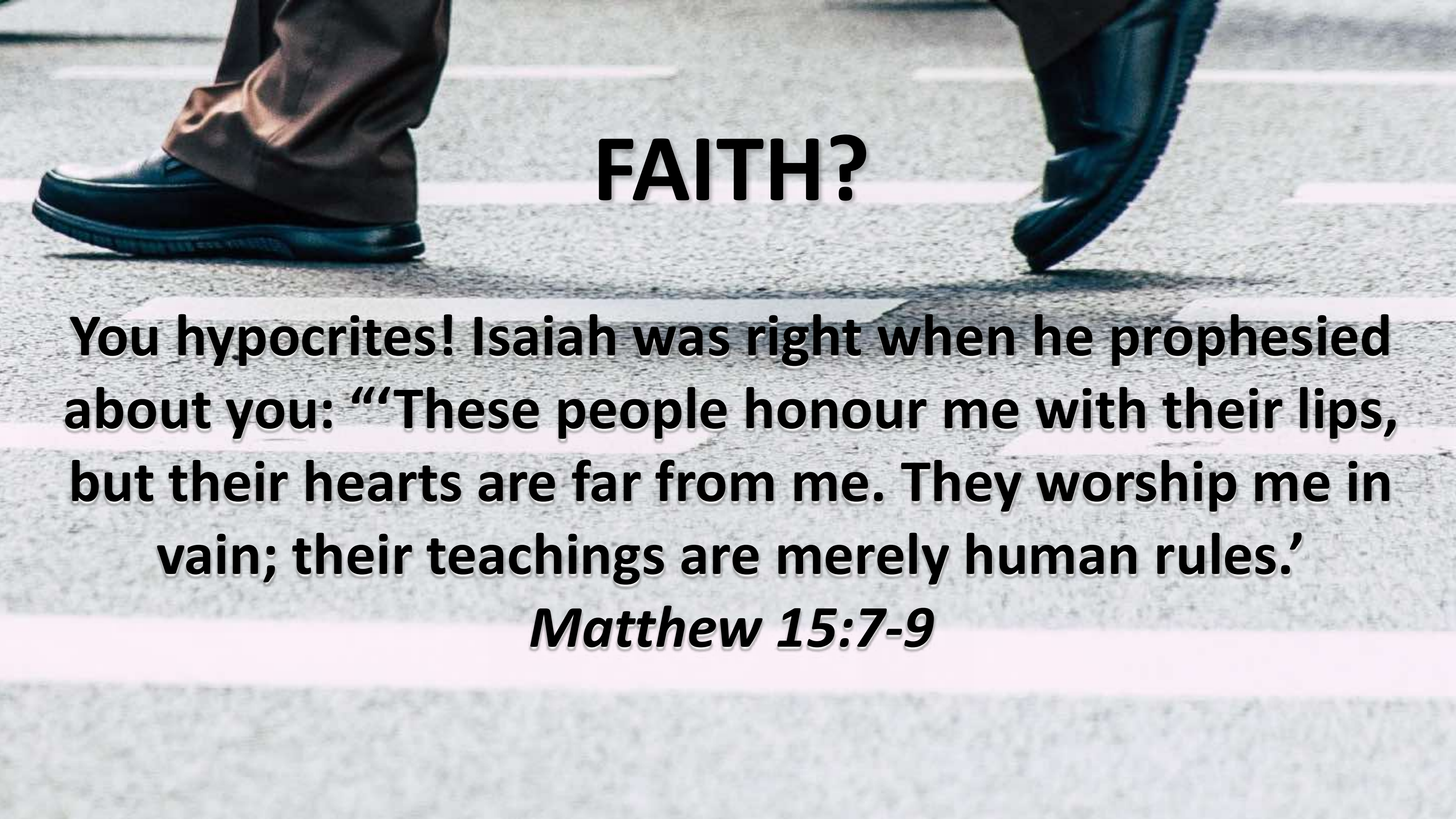

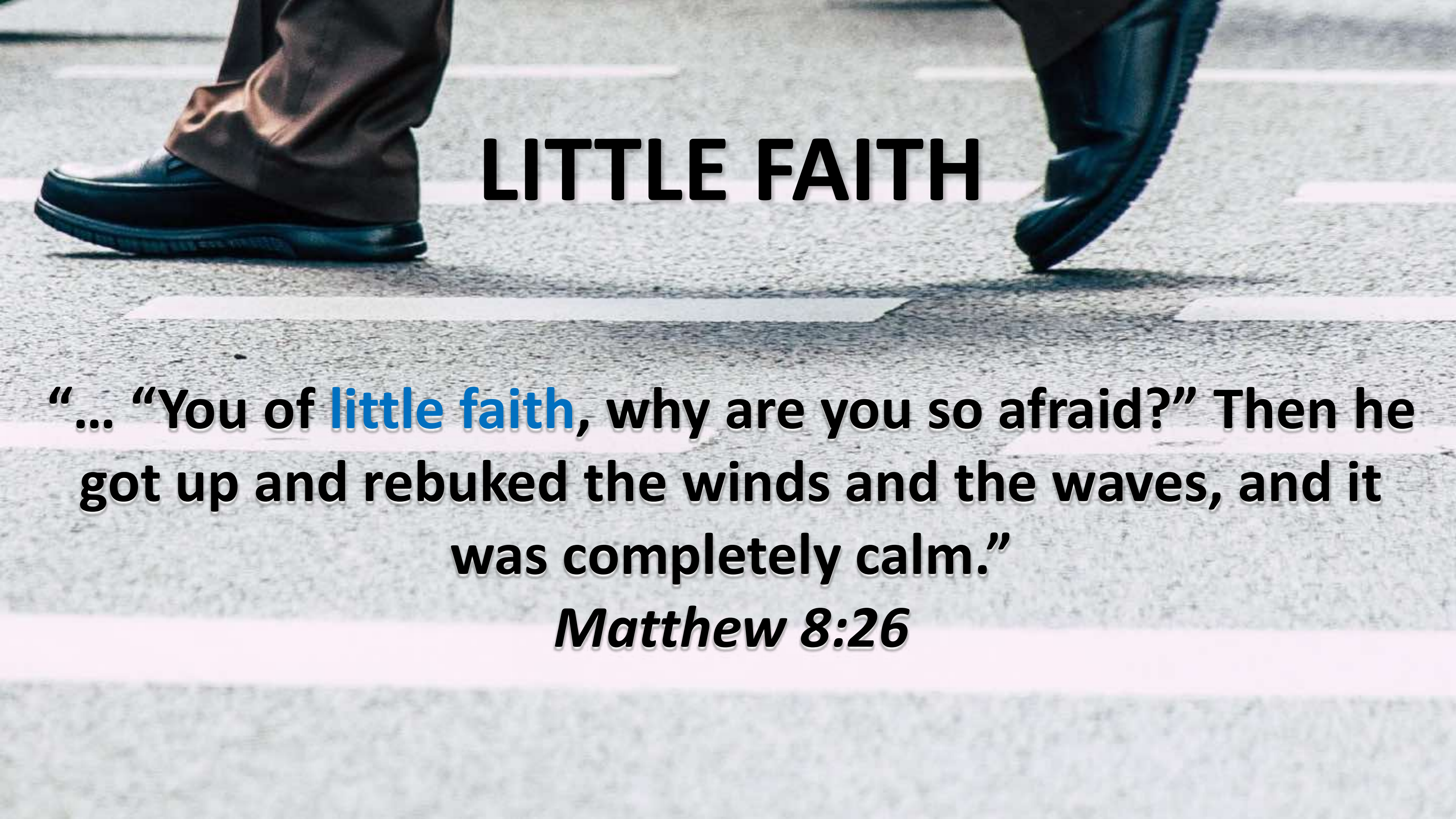




LITTLE FAITH

“... “You of **little faith**, why are you so afraid?” Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.”

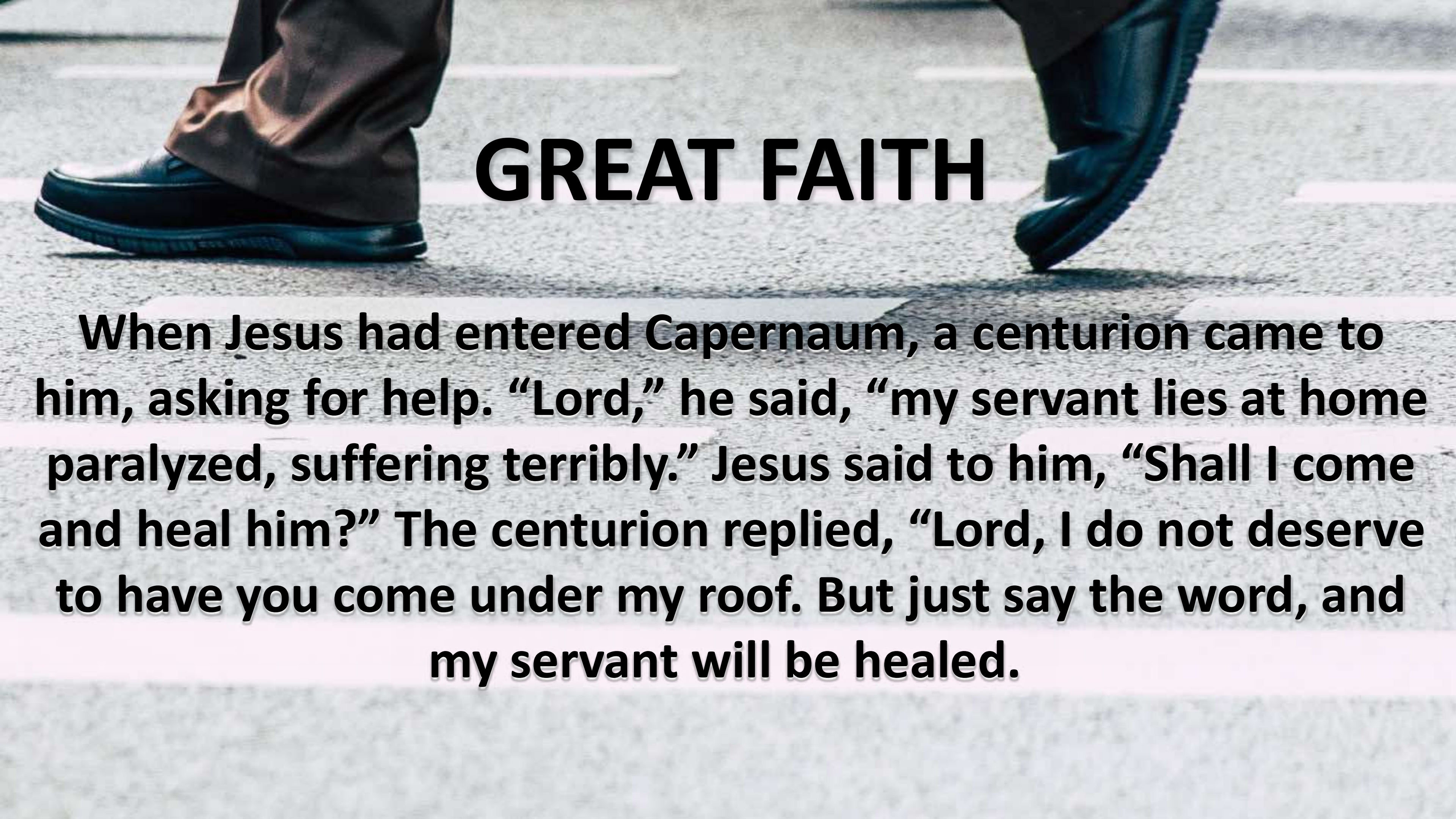

LITTLE FAITH

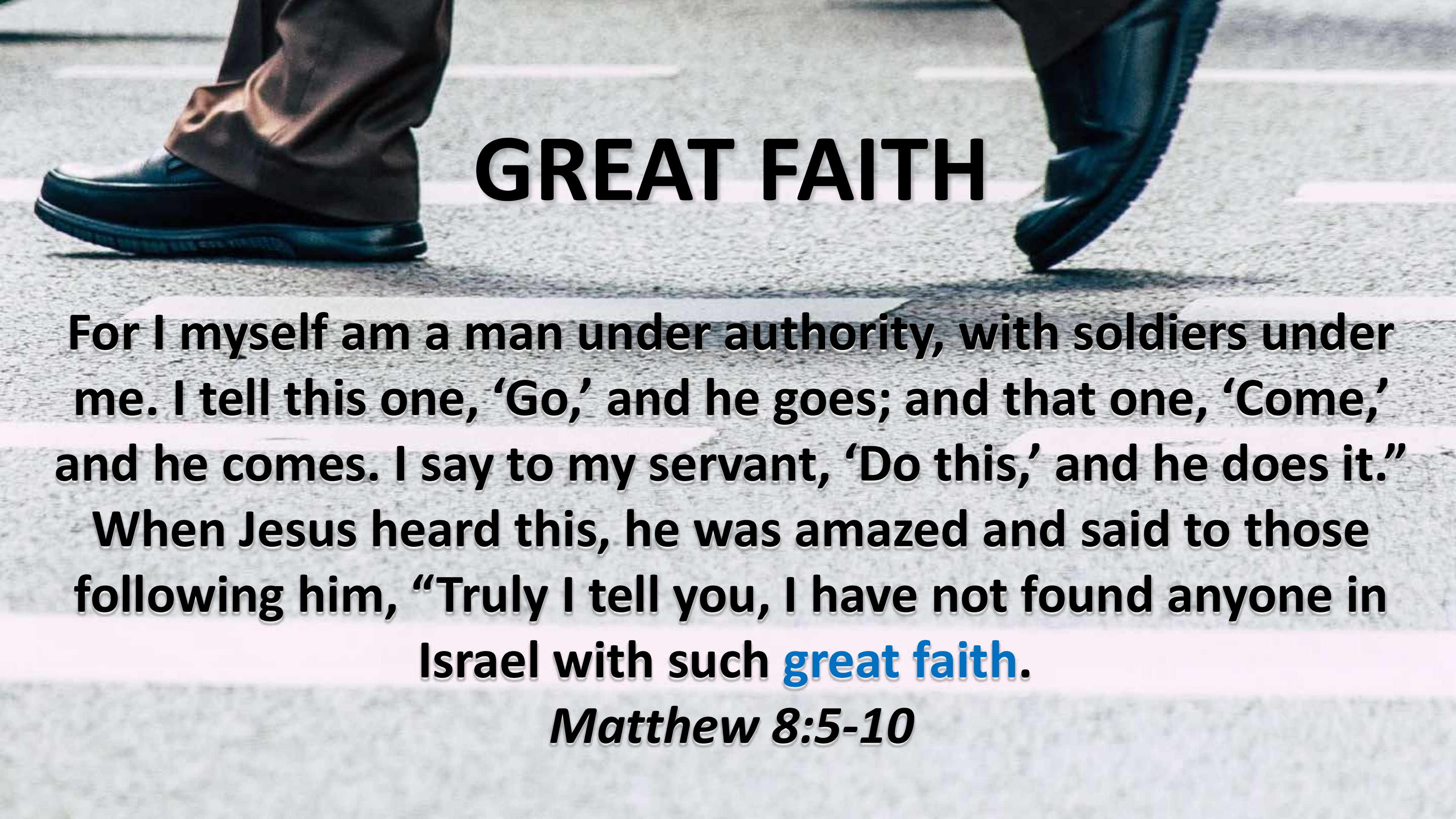
“Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. “You of **little faith**,” he said, “why did you doubt?””

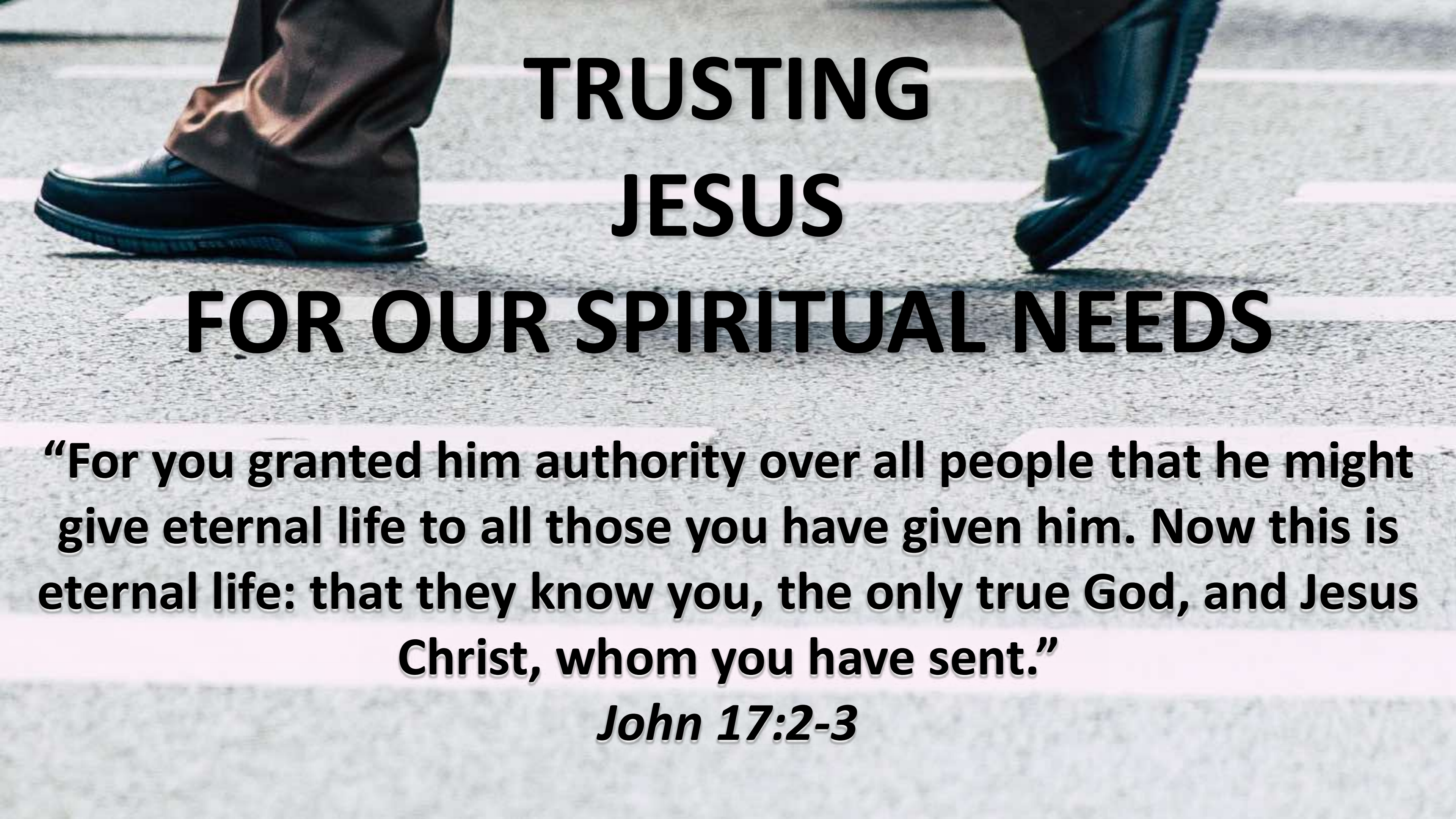

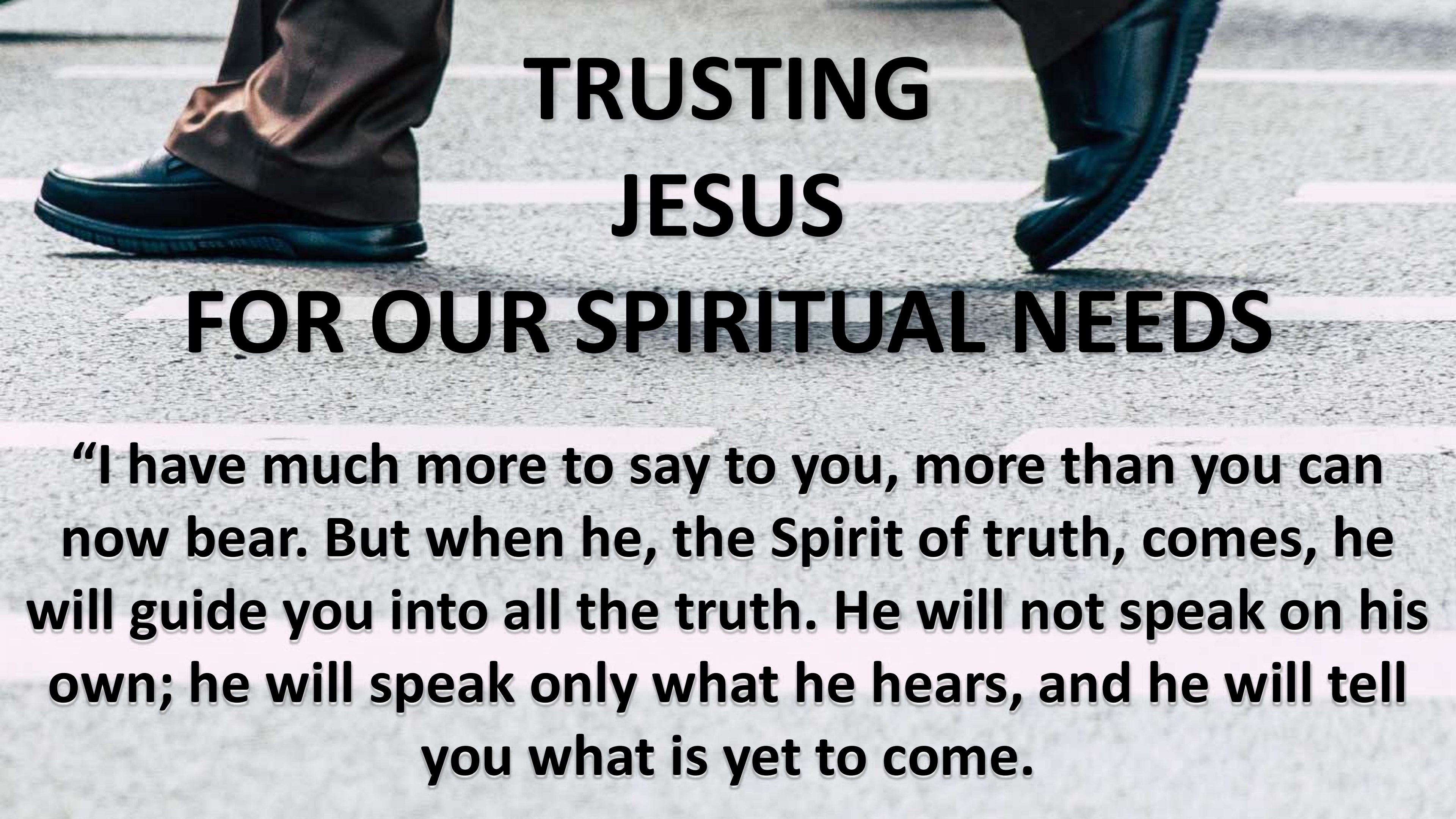


TRUSTING JESUS FOR OUR SPIRITUAL NEEDS

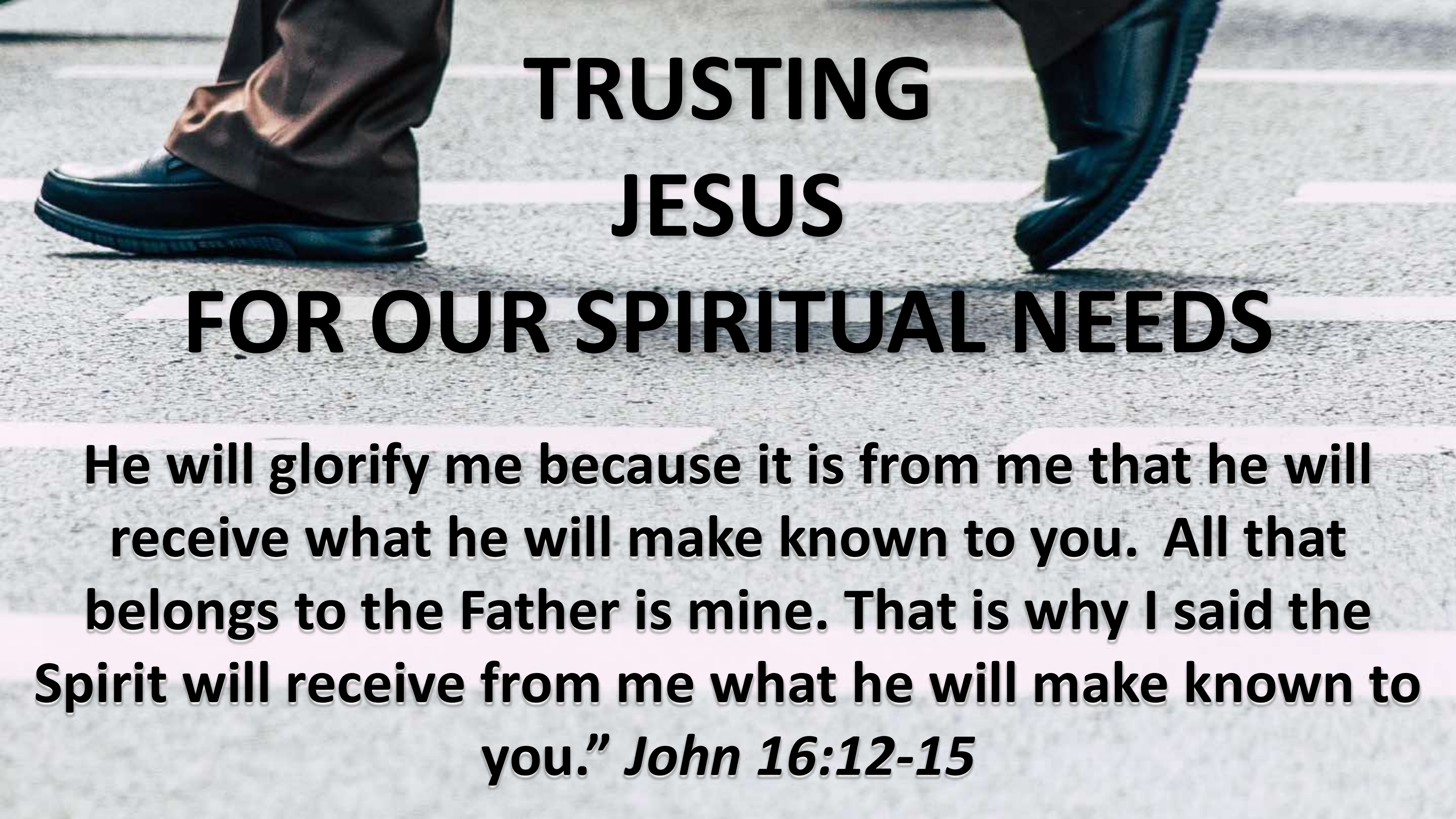

TRUSTING JESUS FOR OUR SPIRITUAL NEEDS

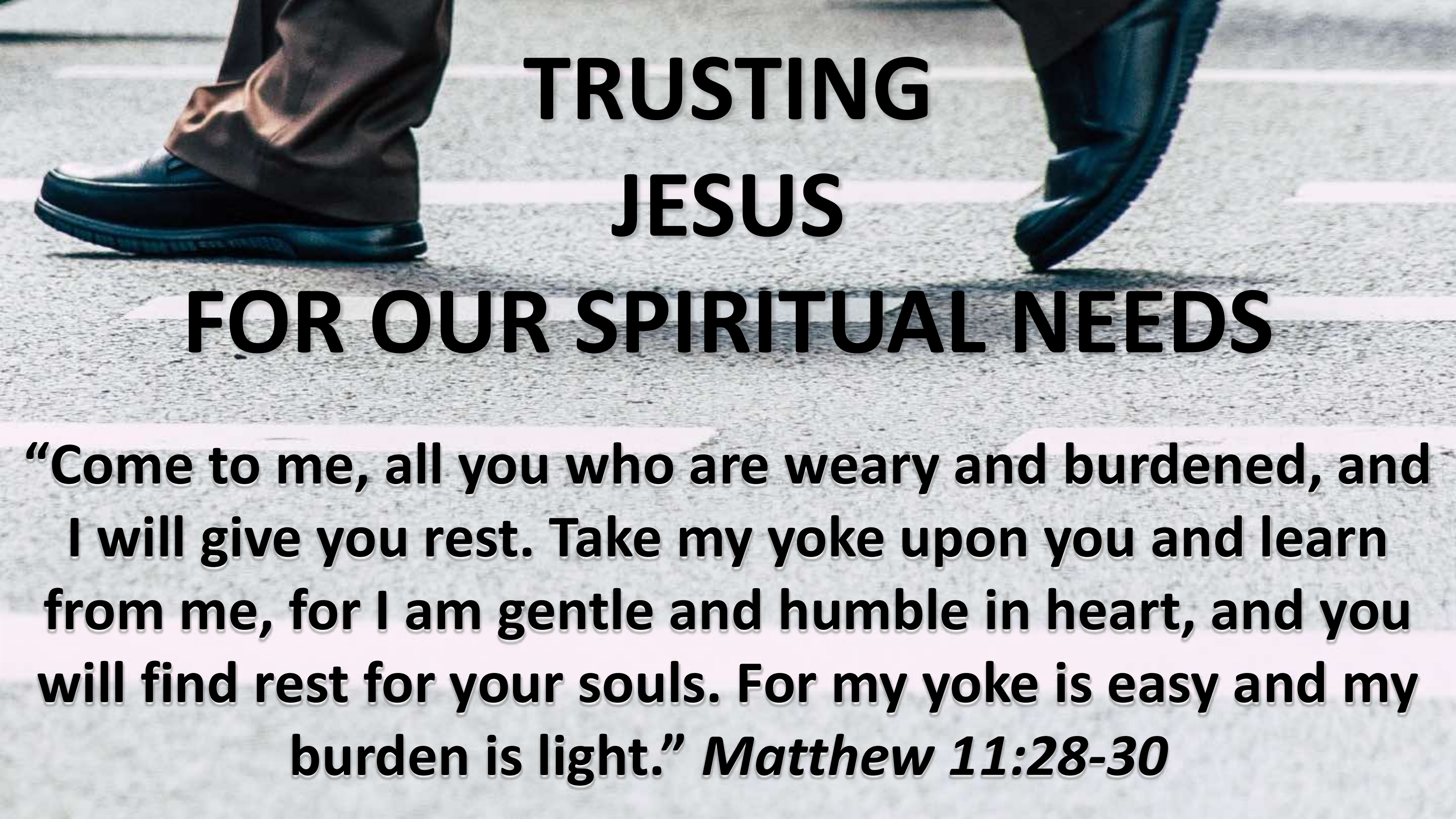

TRUSTING JESUS FOR OUR SPIRITUAL NEEDS

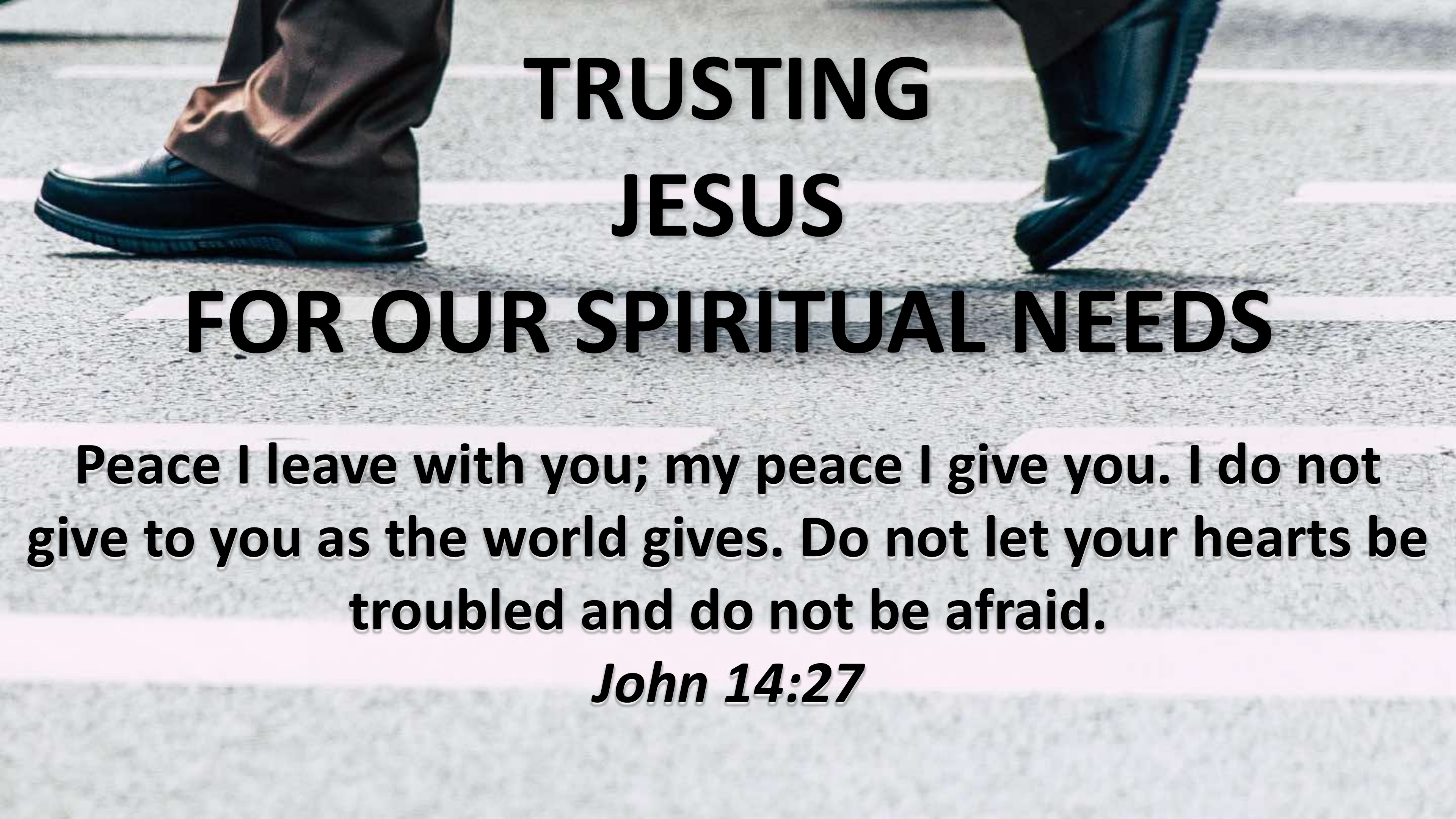

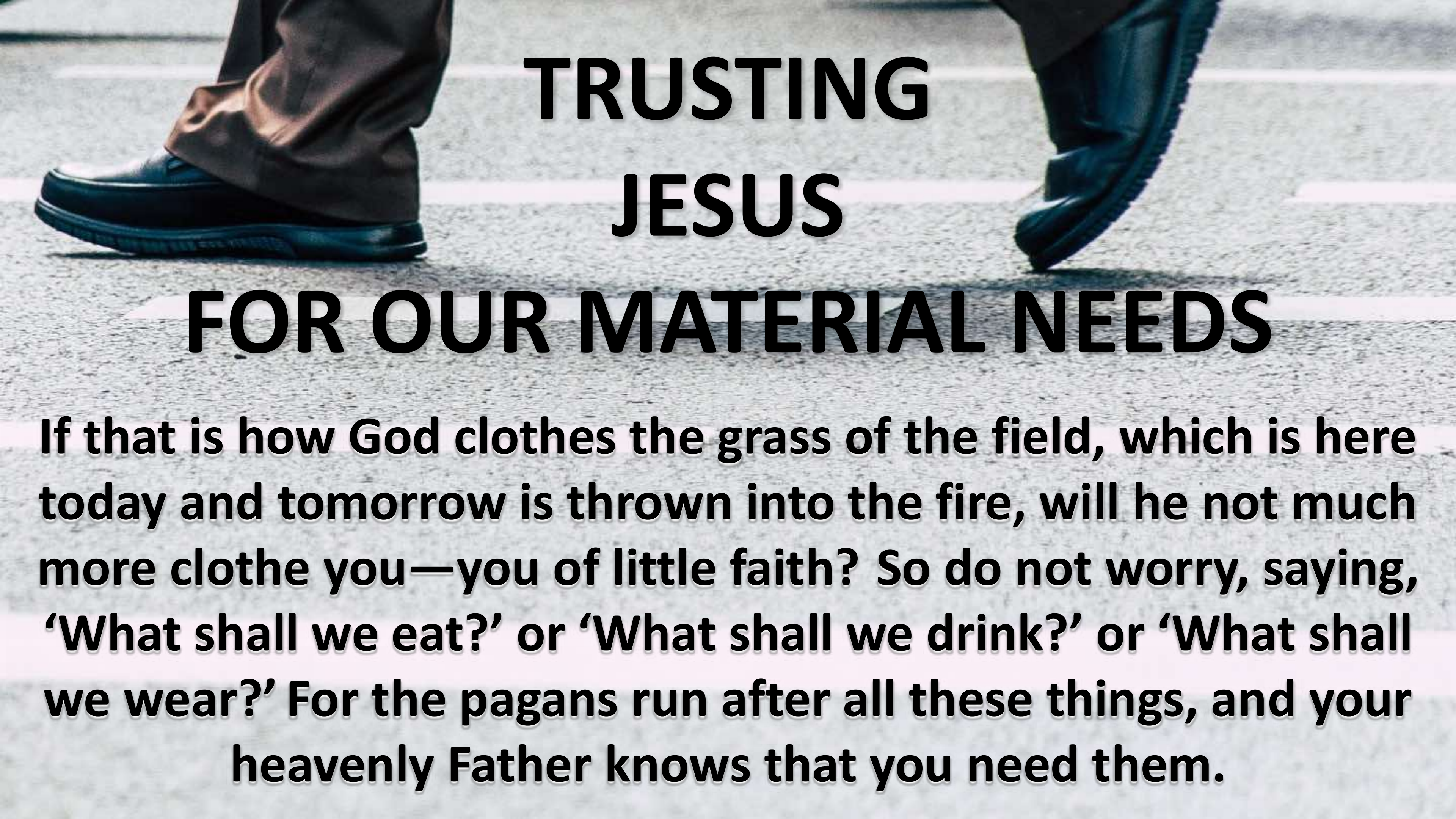


TRUSTING JESUS FOR OUR SPIRITUAL NEEDS

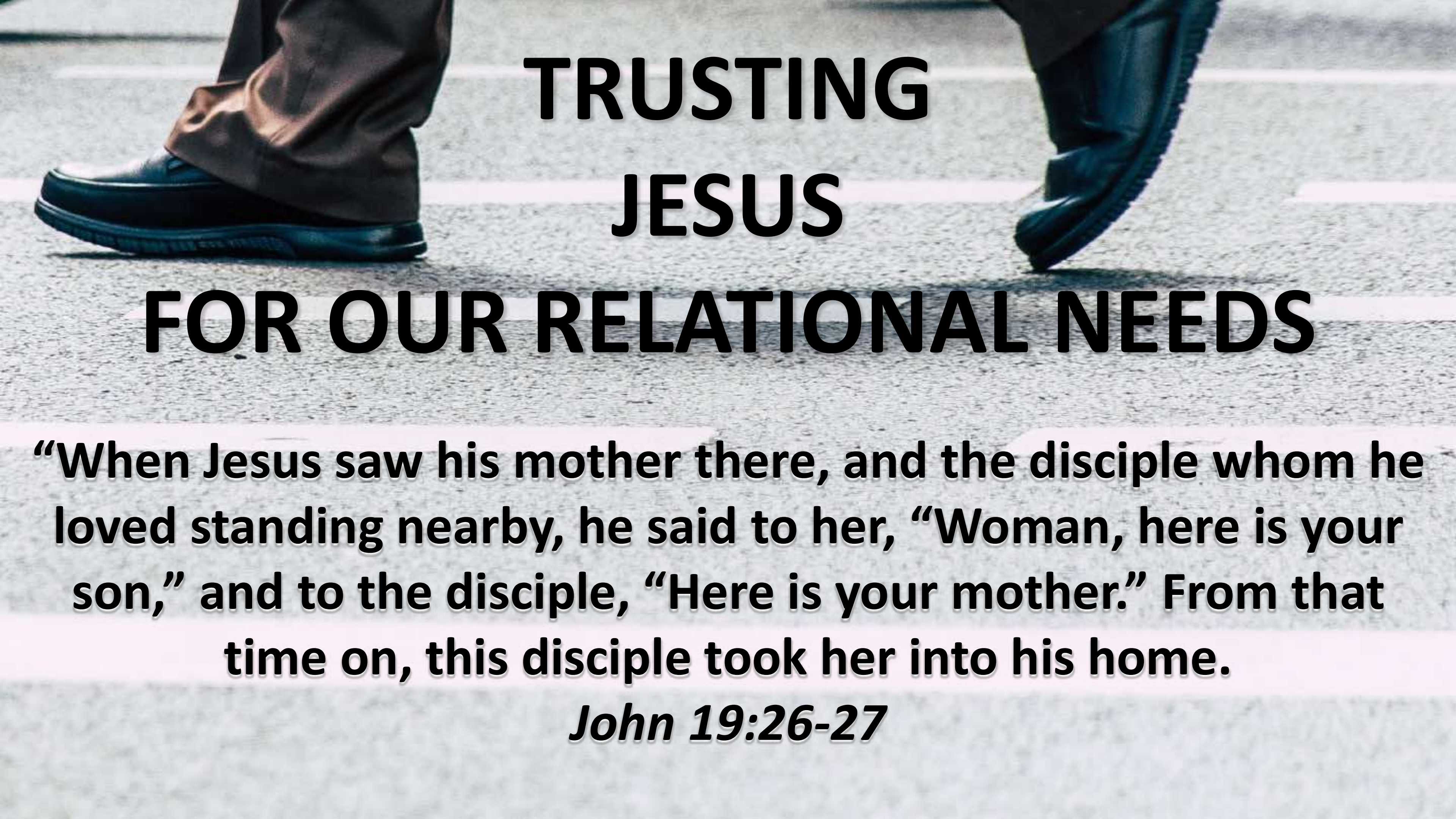


TRUSTING JESUS FOR OUR MATERIAL NEEDS
